The mastic is packaged in 20 oz sausage packs, which are smaller than the packaging for the traditional mastic. The sausage pack, unlike tube mastics, compress down to a small puck which reduces on-site waste and minimizes landfill space. By eliminating waste and reducing VOC's, the mastic helps buildings achieve LEED® recognition.
